- The program providers are Council on International Educational Exchange (CIEE) and School for International Training (SIT).
- GEO Study Abroad Program application deadlines often are earlier than the deadlines set by each program provider because we require extra administrative time to conduct interviews.
- Program applications vary, but most require a general application, essays, transcripts, recommendations, a disciplinary clearance form, and an application fee.
- Our program budgets represent our best estimate of the minimum cost of the entire program, including program cost, personal expenses, visa fees, airfare, and our study abroad fee. Find program budgets in on our website: **geo.uoregon.edu**
