

SPANISH MAJOR Experiential Learning Requirement

For both concentrations of the Spanish major in the Department of Romance Languages, students must complete at least thirty (30) hours of an academic, internship or volunteer experience that involves active use of the Spanish language outside the classroom. **This requirement can be fulfilled through any of the following options:**

VOLUNTEER or INTERN ON YOUR OWN* LOCALLY OR INTERNATIONALLY	Find your own volunteer or internship position requiring active use of Spanish.	A supervisor from the organization/program where the student volunteered must provide the student's assigned Spanish major advisor a letter on official letterhead or from an official organization email, with the following information: student's full name, a description of the responsibilities and tasks the student completed for the organization in Spanish, the total number of hours worked in Spanish (must be a minimum of 30). See your assigned Spanish major advisor for approval.
FIELD WORK COMPONENT OF EXISTING UO CLASS	FHS, EDST, SLAT, etc.	A supervisor from the organization/program where the student volunteered and/or course instructor must provide the student's assigned Spanish major advisor a letter on official letterhead or from an official organization email, with the following information: student's full name, a description of the responsibilities and tasks the student completed for the organization in Spanish, the total number of hours worked in Spanish (must be a minimum of 30). See your assigned Spanish major advisor for approval.

***PLEASE NOTE: Only students registered for the PLE program will receive placement assistance and oversight from the PLE coordinator. If you choose to volunteer or intern on your own, you must make all of your own arrangements.**
